

WORKS NOTIFICATION Ryde Hospital Redevelopment

April 2022

Temporary traffic changes to Denistone Road on Tuesday 18 April and Wednesday 19 April

The NSW Government is investing \$479 million in the redevelopment of Ryde Hospital to meet the future health needs of the growing community.

The redevelopment will provide new and enhanced health facilities and services, including emergency, critical care, inpatient and ambulatory care services. This will transform the delivery of healthcare for the Ryde local community, ensuring people can get the care they need close to home.

How will these changes affect you?

A modular building is being installed at Ryde Hospital to accommodate various hospital services during construction.

On Tuesday 18 April 2023 between 10am and 4pm and Wednesday 19 April 2023 between 9am and 4pm, pieces of the modular building will be transported to Ryde Hospital by truck.

Trucks will enter and exit through the Denistone Road entrance (see map overleaf) to deliver the modular building to the south-east car park (P1A).

For safety, traffic control will be in place on Denistone Road and within the hospital to direct traffic and pedestrians for the duration of the delivery.


Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
