

Out of hours delivery of construction machinery and equipment, Monday 12 August 2024

Oversize equipment delivery scheduled Monday 12 August, between 5am and 6am.

As part of the ongoing works at Ryde Hospital, delivery of a piling machine will be undertaken out of hours, to avoid peak traffic times. To enable this delivery, a construction vehicle will park outside the hospital car park on Denistone Road under traffic control.

The machinery will be unloaded and delivered to the construction site from the Denistone Road site entrance. A section of the northbound lane of Denistone Road will be closed during the delivery, but access will be maintained via the southbound lane with traffic control in place. We ask that where possible you avoid this section of Denistone Road during this period.

These works may result in minor noise impacts from vehicles entering and exiting the area, along with the unloading of equipment.

Normal construction activities will commence from 7am as per standard construction hours. For any questions or concerns about this work, please contact the project team.
