Parking changes from Wednesday 14 May 2025



As we prepare for the construction of the new Acute Services Building parking changes will be implemented from Wednesday 14 May 2025.

What will be changing?

As we expand the construction footprint, there will be further changes to parking. This expansion allows the construction of the new Acute Services Building to begin.

Significant time and effort has been dedicated to implementing an arrangement for car parking that best supports staff, patients and visitors, with careful consideration given to mobility, access and safety.

To accommodate this, a new area has been designated for patient, visitor and accessible parking in the Interim ICU/CCU undercroft.

Parking at Graythwaite Rehabilitation Centre has been reconfigured to better accommodate afternoon staff, visitors, patients, and accessible parking needs

Where can patients and visitors park?

The undercroft parking will be available for patient, visitor and accessible parking. Parking has also been allocated in Graythwaite Rehabilitation Centre.

Patient and visitor parking will be limited to two hours.

Please refer to the parking map above to visualise the new parking arrangements.

Where can I park with a disability parking permit?

Disability parking remains accessible in multiple locations on the Ryde Hospital campus including:

- at the front entry and Emergency Department (accessed from Denistone Road).
- allocated disabled parking in the patient and visitors parking in the undercroft (accessed from Denistone Road).
- at the Graythwaite Rehabilitation Centre (accessed from Fourth Avenue).

Will the Emergency Department and front entrance remain open, and can I still drop off there during the works?

Yes. Access to the Emergency Department and front entrance via Denistone Road will remain open at all times throughout the works. Patients and visitors may continue to use the drop-off zone, and two accessible parking spaces are available.

Will there be onsite parking for staff?

A portion of the onsite parking has been allocated to afternoon staff to ensure their safety at the end of their evening shift. Off-site parking has been provided for all other staff.

Does access to Ryde Hospital change?

Vehicle access to the site will remain the same. Vehicles will enter via Denistone Road, into the undercroft parking area, and exit via the road next to NSW Ambulance. The 2M height restriction for vehicles entering the hospital site will remain.

Pedestrian access will only be available via the main entrances on Denistone Road. Safely make your way to Denistone Road and enter via the current entry points.

How is traffic being managed safely?

Safety is our number one priority. Clear signage will be installed to guide vehicle movements.

Please take care when walking, driving and parking on campus and always follow the direction of the traffic controller.
