Car Parking and the Ryde Hospital Redevelopment

To meet the future health needs of the growing community the NSW Government is providing \$526.8 million for the redevelopment of Ryde Hospital.

The Ryde Hospital Redevelopment will provide new and enhanced health facilities and services, including emergency, critical care, inpatient, community and ambulatory care services. It will also make best use of the current services available at the Ryde campus, including the Graythwaite Rehabilitation Centre and preserving the historic Denistone House.

Alongside the range of clinical services, additional parking will also be delivered to respond to the uplift in services the redevelopment will provide.

Following feedback received from the community and key stakeholders, the proposed approach to car parking has changed, to ensure it meets the needs of surrounding residents, while providing enough car parking spaces for staff and visitors.

Under the revised proposal, to be assessed by the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure the following on-site car parking will be included;



An on-grade (open/ground level) car park towards the back of the site on Ryedale Road as well as a separate on-grade car park at the front of the hospital accessed off Denistone Road.



Underground car parking under the new hospital building, accessed off Denistone Road.

The proposed changes to car parking will maintain the number of parking spaces being delivered as part of the project, and include;

- the removal of the multi-storey car park and replacement with an additional level of basement parking; and
- · additional on-grade car parking.
